Policy Title: Video Surveillance

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The Board of Trustees directs the district administration to implement procedures which are designed to reduce safety risks. The Board authorizes the use of video cameras on district property to ensure the health, welfare and safety of all staff, students and visitors and to safeguard district facilities and equipment. Video cameras may be used in locations deemed appropriate by the superintendent and/or his/her designee.

The district will notify students through student/parent handbooks that video surveillance may occur on district property.

Students in violation of board policies, administrative or building rules, or law will be subject to appropriate disciplinary action. Others may be referred to law enforcement agencies.

Video recordings may become a part of a student's educational record. The district will comply with all applicable state and federal laws related to record maintenance and retention.
