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The Bus Safety Rules

1. **Follow the bus driver's directions.** The bus driver has the authority to assign seats and make seating changes whenever it is necessary to do so.
2. **Use a classroom voice on the bus. Conversation must be restricted to your neighbor.**
3. **Students are allowed to have certain carry-on items (I.E. back packs, some musical instruments) these items must be held in the student's lap. Tobacco/E-cig products, drugs, weapons, laser pointers, radios/loud music, large objects, skateboards, all balloons, glass containers, aerosols/flammables and animals (other than trained service animals) ARE PROHIBITED.**
4. **Sit facing forward and stay in your seat at all times. Standing or changing seats while the bus is moving is not allowed.**
5. **No fighting or "horse play" is allowed. Do not push or shove; keep your hands and feet to yourself.**
6. **Be courteous to others. Bullying will not be tolerated.**
7. **Do not curse or swear. Profanity is not allowed.**
8. **Keep all body parts inside of the bus at all times. Do not throw objects from the bus.**
9. **Do not eat or drink on the bus.**
10. **Do not damage the bus or equipment. Please help to keep the bus clean.**
11. **Students must remain seated until the bus has come to a complete stop and the driver opens the bus door.**
12. **Use the handrail provided when exiting.**
13. **Take twelve steps away from the bus and out of the danger zone. When crossing the road, watch for the driver to signal the way is clear.**

Consequences for non compliance of The Bus Safety Rules

The bus driver will first issue a verbal warning to the student to correct behavior. The driver may also reassign the student to a front seat. If the student does not comply a written warning will be issued and the parent/guardian will be notified.

1st Warning - A written conduct report is issued and parent/guardian will be notified by telephone.

2nd Warning - A written conduct report is issued and parent/guardian will be notified by telephone.

3rd Warning - Student is temporarily suspended from all bus riding privileges. A parent conference with Transportation Supervisor is required before the student may return to the bus. Please contact PFSD Transportation to schedule a conference @ (208) 773-4217

4th Conduct Report-Student is suspended from all bus riding privileges for the remainder of the school year.

Serious infractions of the bus safety rules will be dealt with on a case by case basis by the Transportation Supervisor or Designee and may result in a suspension of bus riding privileges. To aid in the enforcement of the bus safety rules, video surveillance equipment may be randomly in use on all District buses.
