It is the policy of the Board of Trustees to provide a free and appropriate public education to each qualified student with a disability within its jurisdiction.

Students believed to need special education or related services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and/or Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 will be identified and evaluated. If the student qualifies for special education or related services, he/she will be provided with appropriate educational services.

Students with disabilities and their parents have a number of rights and responsibilities. Additional information regarding students with disabilities can be found in the current versions of the Idaho Special Education Manual and/or the district's Section 504 procedures manual.

Questions or requests for information and/or assistance regarding services for students diagnosed or suspected to have disabilities as defined by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act or Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 should be directed to the student's school principal, the Special Education Director or the district's Section 504 Coordinator.
