The Board of Trustees recognizes the value of various technological tools/devices that are currently available, such as cell phones, tablets, video cameras/phones, digital cameras, MP3 players, etc; as well as those that will be developed.

Inappropriate use of the electronic devices will be cause for disciplinary action. The use of these devices to interfere with the instructional setting, harass, annoy and offend others or for cheating on class work/tests is strictly prohibited. Electronic devices are not to be used during class time for personal business. Students are not allowed to use cell phones during class and are not allowed to leave class to place or receive phone calls.

The principal, his/her designee and the classroom instructor may prohibit or limit the use of electronic devices if they are being used inappropriately.
