POST FALLS SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 273

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It is the policy of the Board of Trustees to adopt the provision of the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act, enacted as part of the Education Amendments of 1974 establishing the right of parents to have access to their children's education records and limiting the disclosure of personally identifiable information from education records without parental consent. If a student is eighteen years of age or attending a post-secondary class he/she may exercise these rights on his/her own behalf.
