Policy Title: Confidential Records and Counselor

It is the policy of the Board of Trustees that any certified counselor, psychologist or psychological examiner, duly appointed, regularly employed and designated in such capacity by the school district shall be immune from disclosing, without the consent of the student, any communication made by any student so counseled or examined in any civil or criminal action to which such student is a party. Such matters so communicated shall be privileged and protected against disclosure.

In counseling students it is the duty of the counselor to keep confidentiality, but if a student has committed or was a part of a civil or criminal act, the counselor is required to report.
