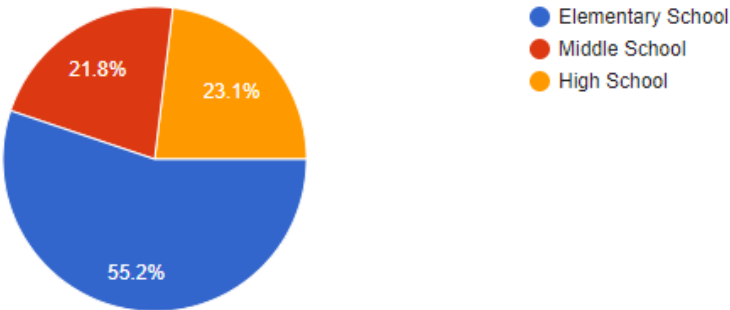

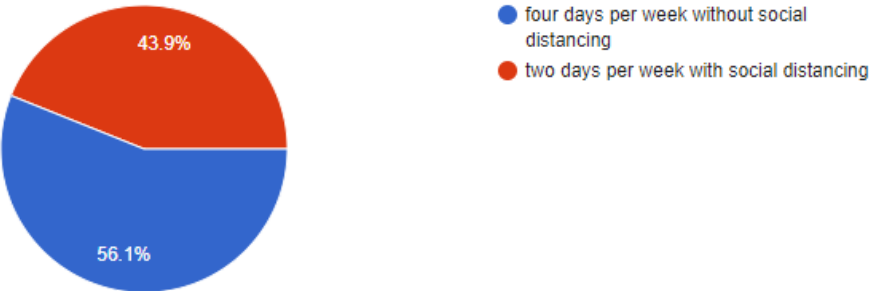
I currently/primarily work at the following level

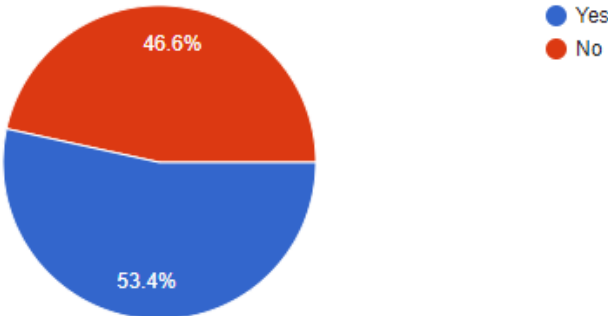

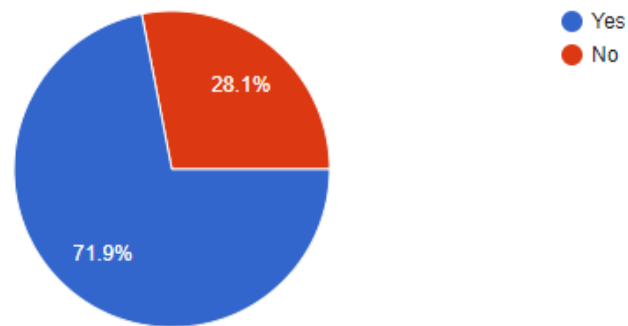
If the Panhandle Health District mask mandate ends, should the school board enact a mask requirement for the Post Falls School District?

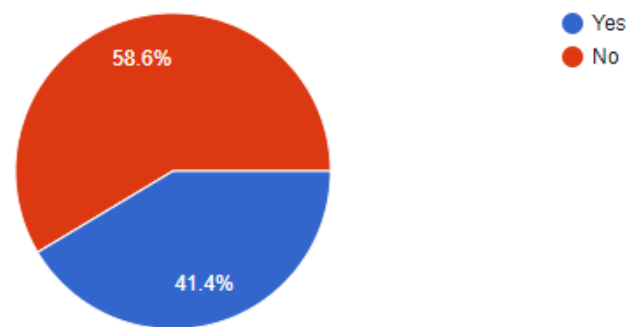

Recognizing COVID-19 will continue to be an issue this school year, rank in order your preference for educating students. 524 Responses

- 192 respondents: first choice was to stay in the hybrid regardless of Kootenai County's color – 36.6%
- 165 respondents: first choice was have school 5 days a week – 31.5%
- 142 respondents: first choice was to continually change based on the county's color – 27.1%
- 25 respondents: first choice was totally remote – 4.8%
